Introducing the event:

The UN's Sustaining Peace agenda emphasizes a comprehensive and preventive strategy that addresses the root causes of conflict, promotes inclusive political processes, and fosters sustainable development. As the 2025 Peacebuilding Architecture Review (PBAR) nears, the Humanitarian-Development-Peace (HDP) nexus approach is expected to influence how the UN and its partners address complex crises, integrating emergency relief, long-term development, and peacebuilding to prevent conflict and strengthen resilience. By linking immediate relief with broader strategies for sustainable peace, the HDP nexus offers a more holistic approach to conflict prevention and resolution, aligning with the UN's vision of "sustaining peace" as outlined in the twin resolutions.

The focus of this event will be placed on the efforts made by the member organizations of the Peace Responsiveness Cross-Organizational Platform to integrate the HDPN approach within their areas of expertise. Selected speakers from various UN Agencies will delve into the progress made, reflect on lessons learned, and identify the challenges that remain.
