Possible entry-points

- Aligning investment promotion strategies with international RBC instruments to incorporate decent work considerations, ensuring that sustainability and labour standards are key factors in attracting and managing investments.
- Integrating the business and human rights agenda into sector strategies and/or industrial policies, in line with the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights and the ILO MNE Declaration, to promote respect for labour and human rights across operations and supply chains.
- Integrating decent work priorities in National Action Plan (NAP) on Business and Human Rights.
- Developing or strengthening national/sectoral strategies on responsible business conduct, with an emphasis on decent work as a cornerstone for sustainable and inclusive development.
