Appointments to the ILO Staff Pension Committee (United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board)

1. In accordance with article 6(c) of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, three members and three alternate members are appointed to the ILO Staff Pension Committee (United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board) by the International Labour Conference on the recommendation of the Governing Body. The Governing Body decided at its 253rd Session (May–June 1992) that appointments to the Staff Pension Committee should reflect tripartite representation.
2. The three-year terms of the following Staff Pension Committee members and alternate members appointed by the Conference are due to expire on 8 October 2025:

3. The Government group proposes the appointment of Ms V. González Posse as member and Mr A. Hado as alternate member. The Employers' group proposes the renewal of the appointment of Mr F. Merle as member with the alternate member position remaining vacant. The Workers' group proposes the renewal of Mr L. Cirigliano as member and Mr C. Pardini as alternate member. All proposed renewals are for a three-year term, from 9 October 2025 to 8 October 2028.
