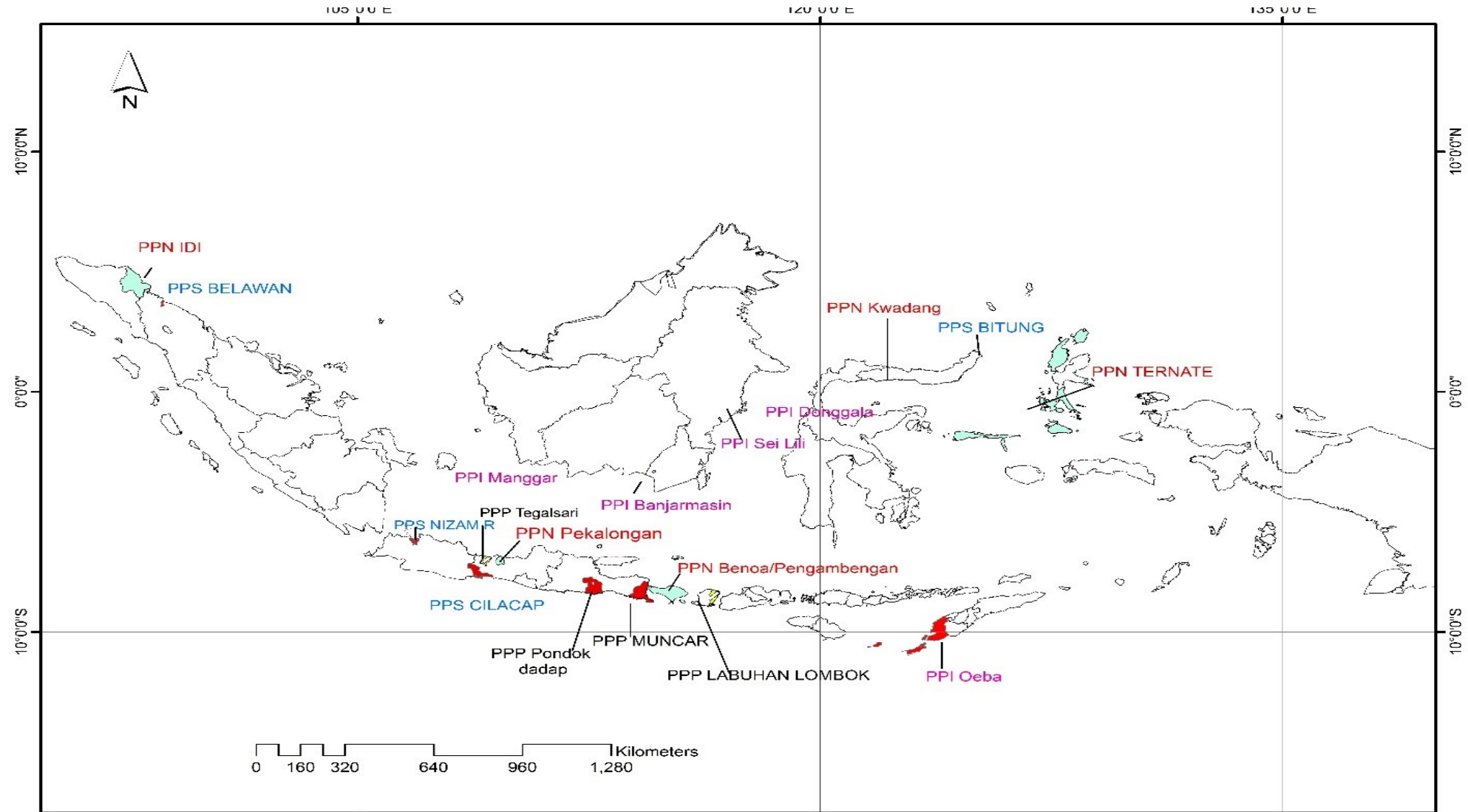

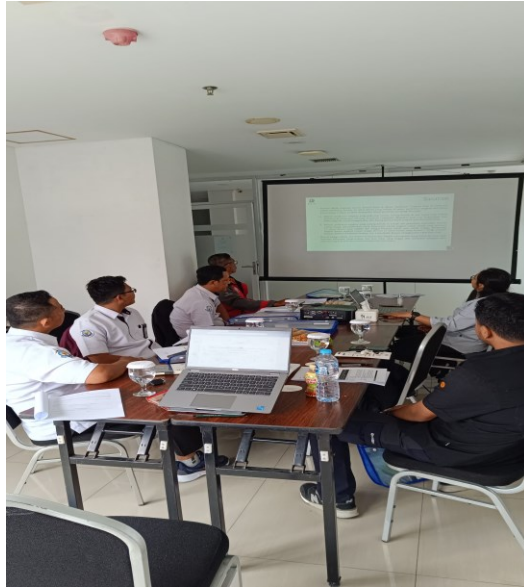
Research step

A. Assessment of the Fishing Workers in the Area of the Study



- Mapping the area of the port
- Characteristics of Fishing Workers (number, distribution, number of vessels anchored, long time at sea, working time, time availability for interview)
- List of Vessel and living area availability
- Assessment for Enumerators
- Contact Person in the Area of Study

B. Training for Enumerator



- 5 enumerators in every port
- 1-2 days training
- Data collection practices
- Strategy for Interview (time, location, procedure)
- Sampling (vessel, Living area, fishing workers)-

C. Interview

1a. Permission to Captain



Some problems in the data collection (vessel-based)

- Sometimes, it is not easy to meet the captain
- In the initial stages, vessel captains generally do not want to give permission for interviews, so a detailed explanation is needed.
- A list of vessels and workers is not available in some ports
- Sometimes, the Captain only gives a limited number of workers in the vessel to be interviewed (2-3 people)
- Once they know each other well enough, they will welcome you

C. Interview

1b. Permission to Village leader



Some problems in the data collection (living area-based)

- The living area of fishers' is remote with limited access.
- The list of fishers' names is unavailable
- Double list name of one HH head in the same village
- The fishers are not present (working at sea, traveling) when interviewed.

2. Doing Interview



Principle for interviewer:

- The interviews should not be conducted when the respondents are at work, are tired, or have conditions that can reduce their concentration
- Choose quiet interview locations so that the respondents can hear the questions clearly
- Ensure that no other person (third party) disturbs the comfort and confidentiality of the information provided by the respondents
- Before conducting the interview, permission should be asked first via the *informed consent*
