Failure to submit instruments to the competent authorities

The Government has provided the following written information.

In reference to the recent observations made by the Committee of Experts regarding the failure of the Government of Bahrain to submit the international labour instruments adopted by the International Labour Conference to the competent national authority, we wish to draw your esteemed attention to the fact that the Kingdom of Bahrain has diligently fulfilled all its obligations in this matter, in accordance with the constitutional framework established by the ILO.

Consistent with our national constitution and established practices, all Conventions and Recommendations adopted by the Conference are submitted to the competent authority for ratification, specifically the esteemed Council of Ministers, encompassing all instruments adopted by the Conference from 2000 to 2023. Moreover, the Government is committed to submitting a comprehensive report to the International Labour Office during the current reporting period, detailing the procedures undertaken in the submission of Conventions and Recommendations to the competent authority.

We respectfully request that this position be given due consideration.
