Plenary vote

A vote is scheduled to be held through an **electronic** system in plenary on **Friday, 13 June** on the proposed **Convention and Recommendation concerning protection against biological hazards in the working environment**.

The President of the Conference will announce that the vote will be opened at around **11:30 (Geneva time)** and closed by **13:00 on 13 June**. The results of the vote will be announced at the afternoon plenary sitting on **13 June**.

The link to the voting platform will be sent by email on **Friday, 13 June by 11:30** to **regular delegates** and their **substitutes**. The first voting code will be included in the email message. The second voting code (four characters) is printed on the Conference badge.

Persons entitled to vote can do so using their own device (**a personal computer or a smartphone**) or on the **voting stations** available **in front of room XX** in the Palais des Nations. The Secretariat will be present to provide any support needed. Any queries may be sent to ILO_eVote_Assistance@ilo.org.

For modifications to credentials to be processed in time for a vote, Focal points must submit them no later than 09:00 on the day a vote is to occur. Substitutions by Employers and Workers must also be submitted by 09:00 on the day a vote is to occur. **Late submissions may not be processed in time for the vote.**
