**WORKING GROUP OF SECTORAL COMMITTEE ON REVITALIZATION OF VOCATIONAL
EDUCATION AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING IN TOURISM SECTOR**

**BY THE GRACE OF ALMIGHTY GOD, MINISTER OF
TOURISM OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,**

Considering : that in order to implement the provisions of Article 3 paragraph (1) of the Regulation of the Coordinating Minister for Human Development and Culture Number 2 of 2024 concerning Guidelines for the Establishment of Working Groups of the Sectoral Committee for the Revitalization of Vocational Education and Vocational Training, it is necessary to stipulate a Decree of the Minister of Tourism concerning the Working Group of the Sectoral Committee for the Revitalization of Vocational Education and Vocational Training in the Tourism Sector;

3. Law Number 10 of 2009 concerning Tourism (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2009 Number 11 and Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4966);

ORDERED:

Establish: DECREE OF THE MINISTER OF TOURISM ON THE WORKING GROUP OF THE SECTORAL COMMITTEE FOR THE REVITALIZATION OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING IN TOURISM.

FIRST : To form a Working Group of the Sectoral Committee for the Revitalization of Vocational Education and Vocational Training in the Tourism Sector with the membership composition as stated in the Annex which is an integral part of this Decision.

SECOND : The Working Group of the Sectoral Committee for the Revitalization of Vocational Education and Vocational Training in the Tourism Sector consists of:

- a. person in charge;
- b. chairman;
- c. members; and
- d. secretariat.

THIRD : The Working Group of the Sectoral Committee for the Revitalization of Vocational Education and Vocational Training in the Tourism Sector as referred to in the SECOND Dictum has the following duties:

- a. Person in charge
is responsible for the work of the Working Group of the Sectoral Committee on Revitalization of Vocational Education and Vocational Training in the Tourism Sector.

- b. The Chairperson
is responsible to the person in charge and reports the results of the work to the Minister of Tourism through the person in charge at least once every 6 (six) months or at any time if necessary.
- c. Members
 - 1. provide input provide input to ministries/institutions regarding current and future labor needs in the industry sector, including information on the number of needs, location of needs, and skills required;
 - 2. assist in developing occupational maps and qualification frameworks for the sector;
 - 3. provide review and input on the required competency standards;
 - 4. provide recommendations related to program design and curriculum for vocational education and vocational training;
 - 5. assisting the development of apprenticeship/industrial work practice/field work training;
 - 6. bridging the updating process of Vocational Education and Vocational Training provider institutions to be in accordance with technological developments and skills needs in the industry; and
 - 7. coordinate with the respective sector ministries/agencies and the head of the implementation team.
- d. Secretariat
assists in the secretarial administration of the Working Group of the Sectoral Committee on Revitalization of Vocational Education and Vocational Training.

FOURTH : In carrying out the duties as referred to in the **THIRD** dictum, the Working Group of the Sectoral Committee for the Revitalization of Vocational Education and Vocational Training in the Tourism Sector shall be guided by the national strategy for the revitalization of vocational education and vocational training.

FIFTH : The Working Group of the Sectoral Committee for the Revitalization of Vocational Education and Vocational Training in the Tourism Sector applies the principles of coordination, integration, and synchronization of policies, planning, and budgeting in the implementation of the revitalization of Vocational Education and Vocational Training.

SIXTH : Costs arising from this Ministerial Decree shall be borne by the State Budget of the Ministry of Tourism and other ministries/institutions and other legal sources in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulations.

SEVENTH : This Ministerial Decree shall come into force on the date of its enactment until December 31, 2025.
