Stay Safe:

Before Use



Check tools for cracks,
rust, or loose handles



Clean tools (especially
after chemical use)



Choose comfortable,
well-sized tools



Keep first aid kit nearby

During Use



Hold tools properly → avoid
twisting or awkward bending



Wear gloves & goggles



Don't carry sharp tools in
pockets or throw them



Never run while holding sharp tools

Storage



Clean & dry before storing



Store in a safe area, off the ground,
away from children



Cover sharp edges when not in use
