Injuries Resulting from Handling Livestock and Wild Animals

Risks:

01

Kicks, bites, crushing, skin infections or headbutts

Eye injuries from horns /tails

02

Falls on slippery barn floors (milking, Birth support)

Strains from restraining animals



Stay Safe:



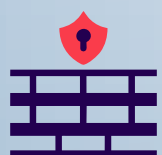
Stay calm, approach animals slowly, not from behind



Avoid loud sounds & sudden movements



Know the "Flight Zone" & balance point (safe approach)



Keep barriers/fences strong & secure



Install slip-resistant barn/walkway floors



Isolate aggressive or sick animals → call a vet



Boots, gloves, long sleeves, Goggles/face shield near animals with horns or spraying

If injured or showing unusual symptoms → **seek medical help immediately**
