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2025	Ghana	103	/	/	Provided - A two-day tripartite workshop was organized in July 2025 which consisted of presentations, discussions, and collection of inputs from stakeholders on various International Labour Standards. Regarding Convention 103, the presentation covered the reporting obligations, pending comments, follow-up to the CAN recommendations, and the reporting cycle scheduled for 2030. It focused on specific articles of the Convention, including compulsory maternity leave, extension of maternity leave in case of late childbirth, cash benefits, and prohibition of dismissal during the protected period. The main recommendations were the following: 1) Prioritizing legislative reforms and amendments to the Labour Law could address key issues such as mandatory maternity leave, automatic extension of prenatal leave, and prohibition of dismissal in the short-term period; 2) For mid-term solutions, legislative and institutional reforms on a compulsory social insurance scheme could address the gaps in cash benefits; 3) An assessment of compliance prior to ratification of Convention 183 would be necessary, considering that Convention 103 will be abrogated in the future.
