Surveys reveal enhanced knowledge and RBC readiness, as well as internal replication by OEM firms in their supply chain.

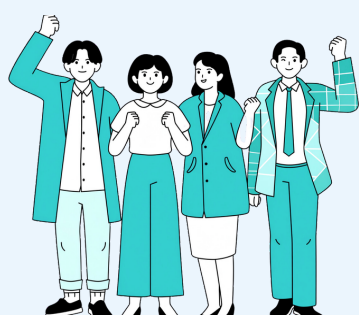


► Policy influence

- TLS revisions will help drive higher RBC standards in the automotive sector and beyond.
