Plenary vote

A vote is scheduled to be held through an **electronic** system on **Friday, 12 June** on the proposed **Convention concerning decent work in the platform economy**.

The vote will open at around **10:45 am (Geneva time) on 12 June** and closed **the same day by 12:00 pm**. The results of the vote will be announced at the morning plenary sitting on **12 June**.

The link to the voting platform will be sent by email on **Friday, 12 June by 10.45 am** to **regular delegates** and their **substitutes**. The first voting code will be included in the email message. The second voting code (four characters) is printed on the Conference badge.

Persons entitled to vote can do so using their own device (**a personal computer or a smartphone**) or on the **voting stations** available **in the Salle des pas perdus, behind the Assembly Hall** at the Palais des Nations, and **in front of the Governing Body room (currently used by the Committee on the Application of Standards)** at the ILO building. The Secretariat will be present at both locations to provide any support needed. Any queries may be sent to meetingsupport@ilo.org.

For modifications to credentials to be processed in time for a vote, focal points must submit them no later than 09:00 am on the day the vote is scheduled to take place. Substitutions by Employers and Workers must also be submitted by 09:00 am. **Late submissions may not be processed on time for the vote.**
