

Governments

1. To promote and spread decent work principles.
2. To solve the problems of labor market differences.
3. To encourage the three parties (employees, employers and the government) to actively participate in the different international partnerships, including the ILO.
4. To reinforce inspection mechanisms and raise relevant awareness and organize seminars on inspection mechanisms by the ILO.
5. To recommend the examination of the minimum wage status in the Gulf States taking in consideration its repercussions on the public and private sectors in particular and on the macro economy in general.
6. To promote, reinforce and activate the tripartite dialogue and the ILO's participation to this dialogue.

7. To carry out continuous economic analytical studies, on a regular basis, with the support of the ILO to minimum wages in the case of their implementation.
8. To hold seminars on wages and wage policies in the ministry of labor.
9. To develop global legislations concerning wage policies in order to bridge the gap between the public and the private sectors, in line with the ratified international legislations and conventions.
10. To call the ILO to find controls or special systems that address the issue of free zones and to participate in organizing the labor market in that region.
