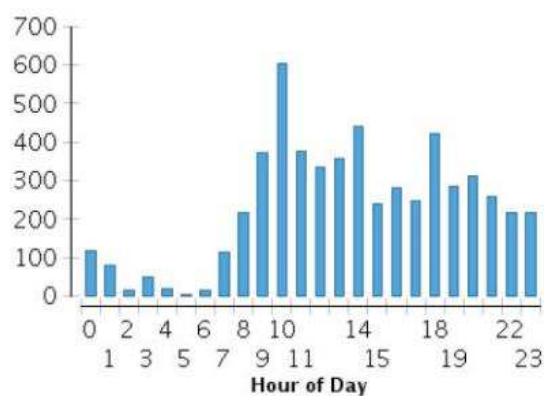
Diploma of Conservation & Land Management
