Strategy

- Green Jobs demonstration program which respond to the different needs of women and men, implemented in specific sectors selected based on consultations with ILO constituents

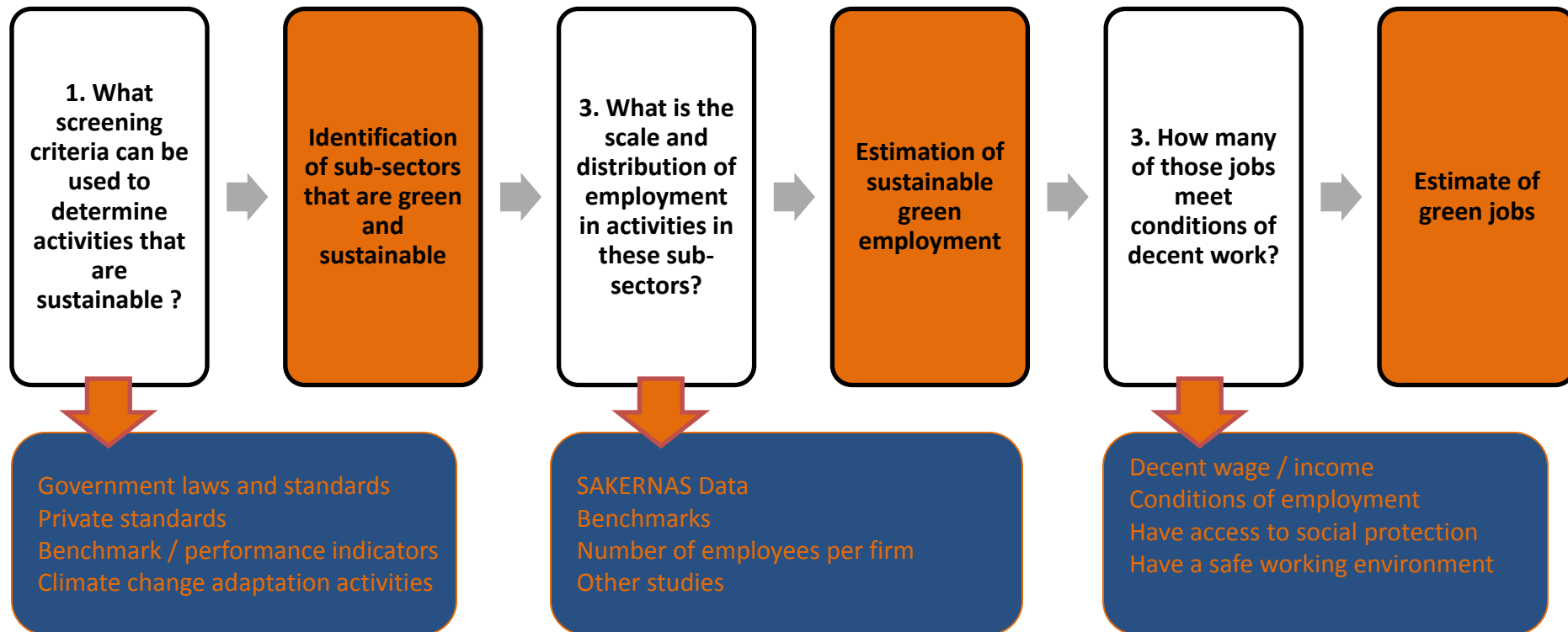

1. SFM Production forests	Law no. 41/1999 on forestry President instruction no. 4/2005 on elimination of illegal logging	56.000-800.000		
2. LEI/FSC certified production forests	Private standard: LEI/FSC certification	565.000		
3. SFM Protected forests	Benchmark : Management plan	3.000-10.000		
4. Sustainably managed protected forests	Benchmark: Compliance with forestry and employment regulations	35.000		
5. Forest fire prevention	Benchmark: Avoided CO2, sequestered CO2, habitat protection	5.750-7.000
