

Organizing in the 21st Century

Project background

The project intends to improve the capacities of the labor movement to organize workers amidst increasing precariousness of work in the country. It also aims for labor organizers to improve their organizing capabilities and explore possibilities to identify models for organizing in “non-traditional” ways. It will also provide a venue for them to analyze barriers in organizing both in public and private sectors and identify if there are efforts ongoing to address the current problem.

Project Objective

- At least 30 senior and junior organizers from participating unions have improved their organizing knowledge, skills and attitudes;
- Organizing models in the public and private sectors as well as formal and informal economies have been assessed and documented; and
- A common trade union reform agenda on strengthening the constitutional right to self-organization is developed.
