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Background

- Indonesia is both a sending and receiving country of international migrant labour
- Annually Indonesia approximately 250.000 to 500.000 migrant labours worked in Southeast Asia, East Asia, and the Middle East
- Data on international labour migration are closely related to issues such as undocumented worker, trafficking, remittance, prosperity, national security, etc.
- The collection, analysis, and sharing of migration data is imperative in the development of cohesive and suitable legislations, policies and programs for migrant workers

Data Sources

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➤ Primary Data:

- Population Census
- Population Surveys: Intercensal Population Survey, National Socio-economic Survey

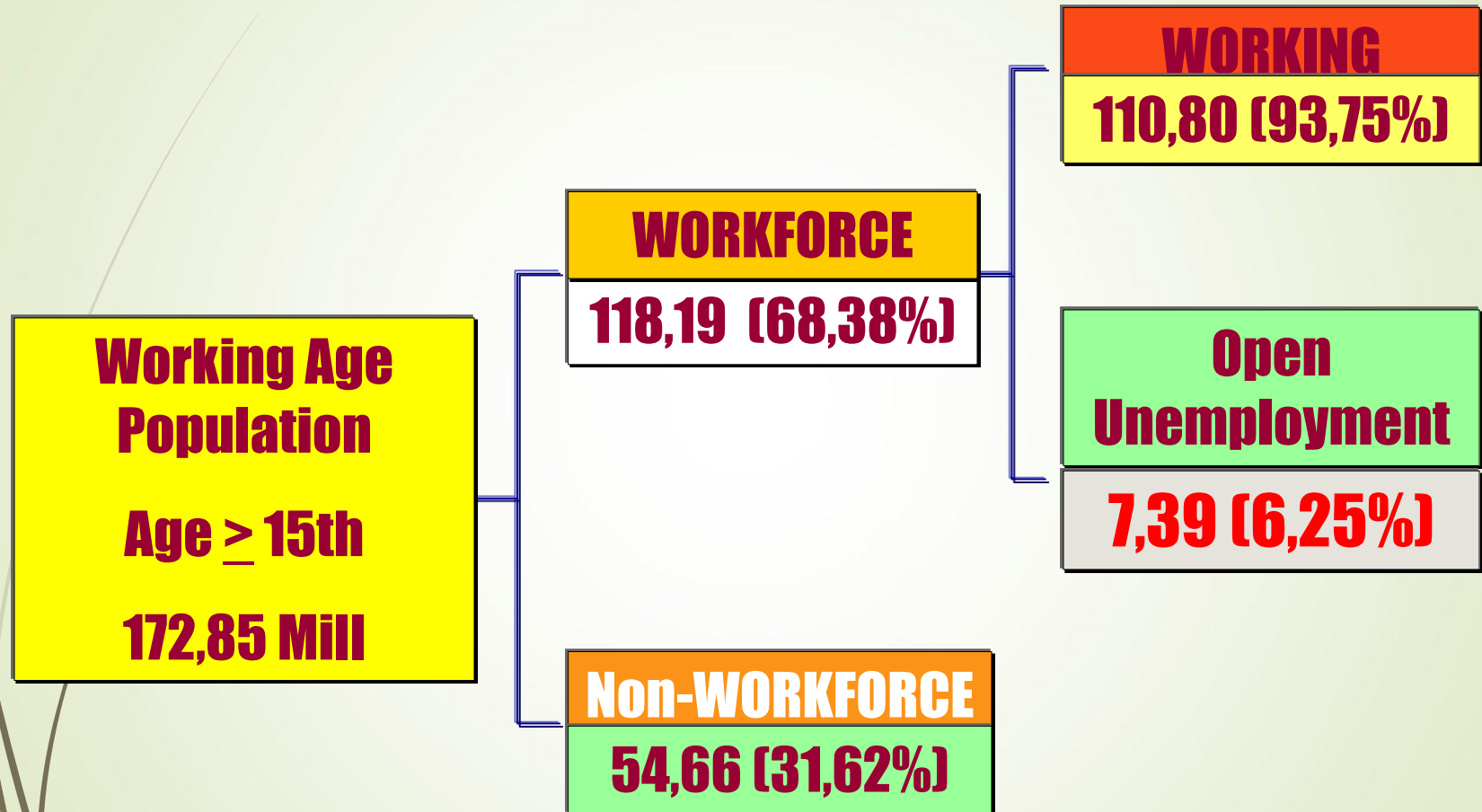
➤ Secondary Data:

 - BNP2TKI (National Board for the Placement and Protection of Indonesian Workers)
 - Ministry of Law and Human Right: Directorate General of Immigration, Directorate of Transboundary

Data Source of Indonesian Population

- Population Census (Sensus Penduduk/SP) 1971, 1980, 1990, 2000 dan 2010.
- Vital Registration System: Population Administration Information System (Sistem Informasi Administrasi Kependudukan /SIAK)
- Intecensal Population Survey (Survei Penduduk Antar Sensus /SUPAS) 1976, 1985, 1995 dan 2005
- Indonesian Population Survey (SPI) 1987 and Data Survey of Indonesian Population (SDKI) 1991, 1994, 1997, 2002-2003, 2007 and SDKI 2012
- National Social Economic Survey (Survei Sosial Ekonomi Nasional /SUSENAS)
- **National Workforce Survey (Survei Angkatan Kerja Nasional /SAKERNAS)**
- Indonesian Family Life Survey (IFLS) 1993, 1997, 1998, 2000 dan 2007/2008
- Household Health Survey 1980 dan 2004
- Basic Health Survey 2007 dan 2010

SOURCE OF DATA RELATED TO MIGRANT WORKERS (1):

1. Job Seeker Data in District/City Government Offices

Job seeker who wants to work abroad must be registered in District / City Government Institutions responsible for Ministry of Manpower Affairs

2. Migrant Worker registered in BNPTKI (SISKOTKLN)

Every Indonesia migrant worker who should work abroad must registered to the National Board for Placement and Protection of Indonesia Overseas Worker (NBPPIOW)

3. Data reported by Indonesia Agency

Indonesia Placement Agency must report periodically the placement of migrant workers to Minister of Manpower

DATA RELATED TO MIGRANT WORKERS (2):

4. Data from Immigration

Embarkation and Disembarkation data of migrant workers

5. Data in the Embassies and Consulates

Every Indonesian migrant worker is required by law to notify and report the arrival, existence and repatriation of worker to the Indonesian Embassies and Consulates in the destination country



The institutions authorized to conduct data collection of Migrant Workers

- **Labour Affairs Offices in City/District**
- **Ministry Of Manpower**
- **National Board Of Placement and Protection of Indonesian Overseas Workers (NBPPIOW)**
- **Immigration**
- **Indonesian Embassies and Consulates**

Application of Migrant Workers Data to Migration of Worker Policy in Indonesia

Related to:

1. Policies formulation for Indonesian migrant worker candidate, such as: recruitment process, training and competency examination, document preparation, medical and psychological examination, monitoring and evaluation;
2. Resident and Working Permit policies
International labour **in**-migration data (foreign workers enter to Indonesia) important to formulate resident permit and work permit policies;
3. Dispute settlement mechanism for Indonesian migrant worker problems/cases;
4. Treatment for Irregular Migrant Workers;
5. Other policies

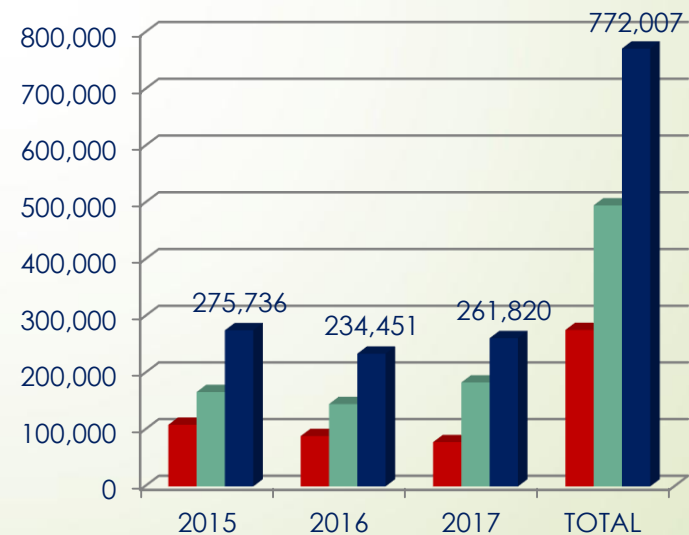
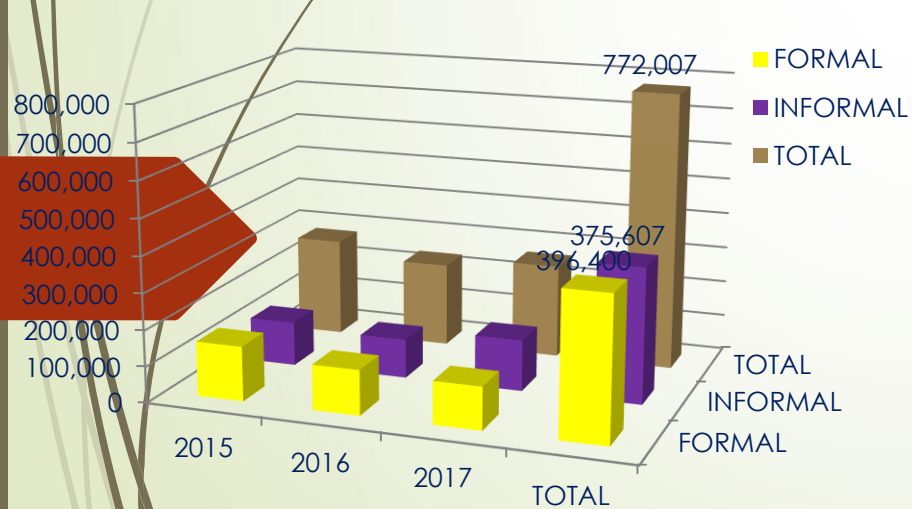
Data of Dispute Settlement for Indonesian Migrant Worker Cases

Data of Indonesian migrant workers cases and its settlement can be collected from the **Institutions** who in charge of cases settlement, such as:

1. Representatives of Government of Indonesia (Labour Attache, Consular, etc)
2. Indonesian Employment Agencies and Foreign Worker Employment Agencies in destination countries
3. National Board for Placement and Protection Indonesia Overseas Workers **Crisis Center**
4. Insurance Companies

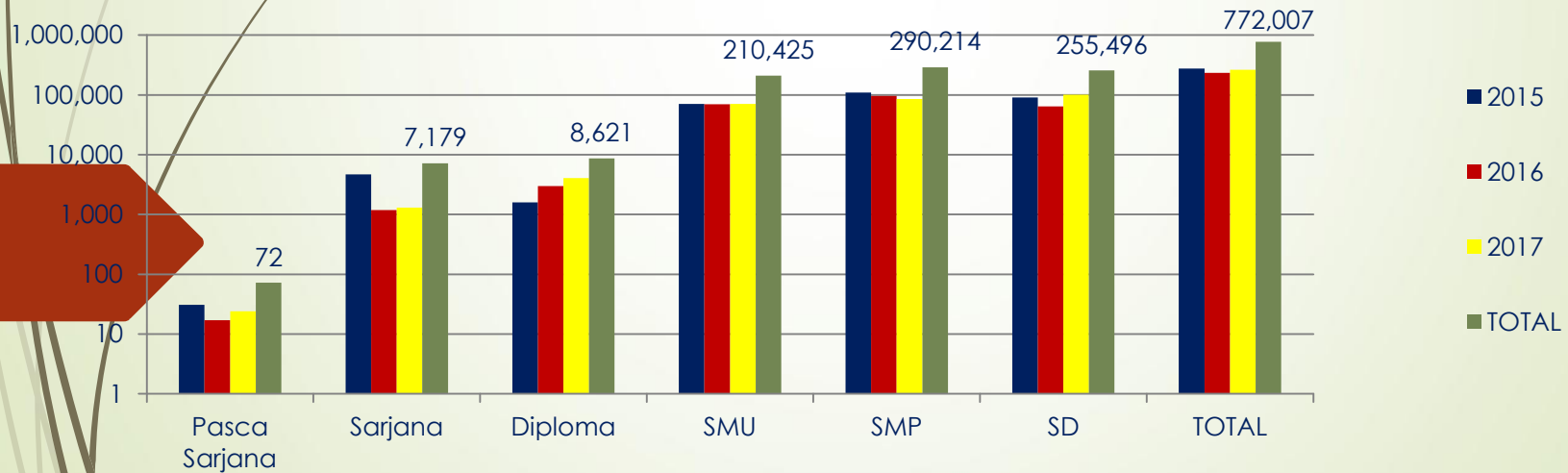

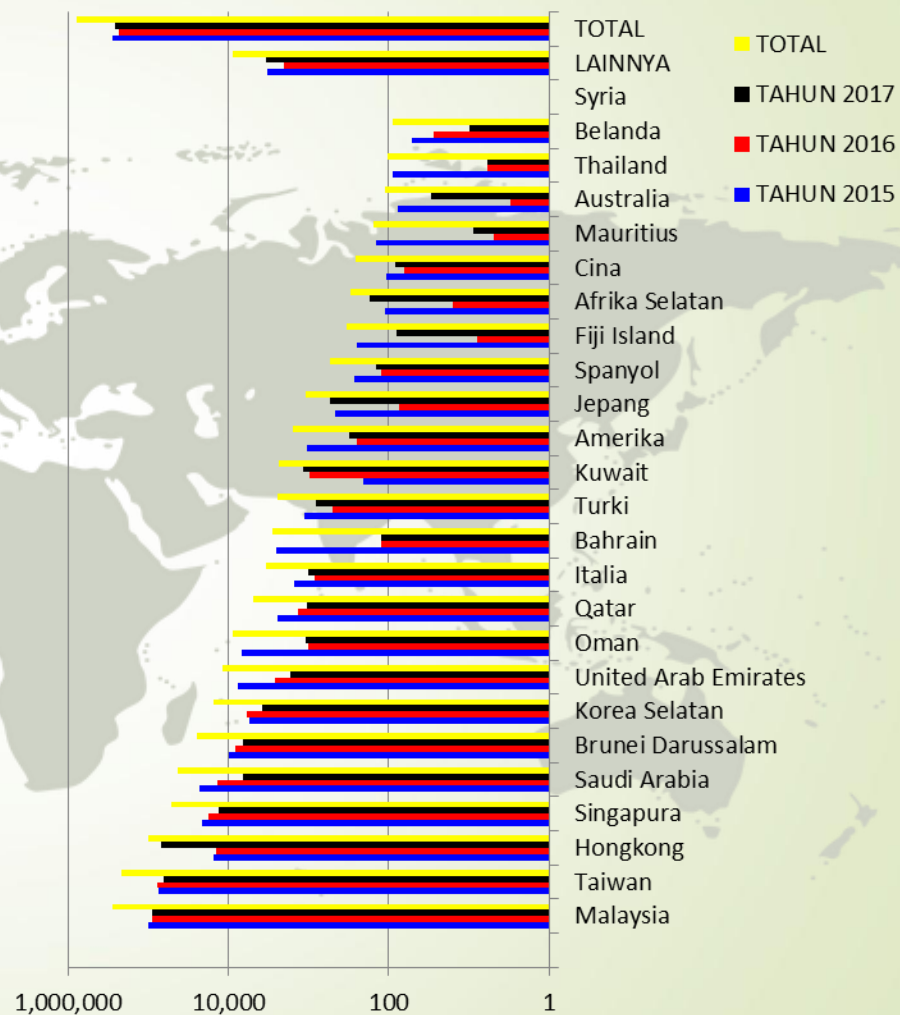

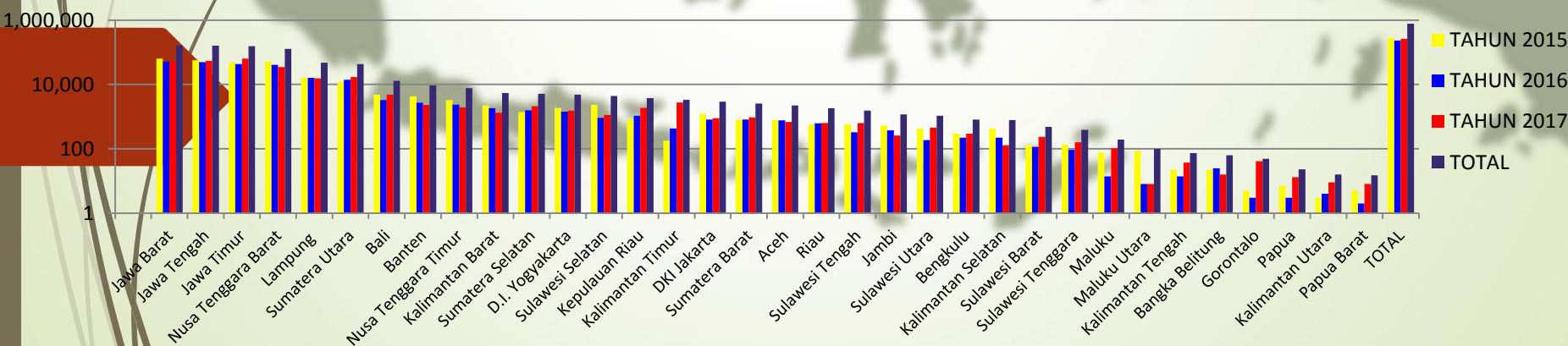
