

► Risk management online training course

7 December 2021

► Course content

The training is organised in the ILO-VCCI collaboration framework with the support from the European Union (EU) and other donors to promote Decent Work in the electronics global supply chains in Viet Nam. It aims to promote the establishment of an effective risk management system in the electronic manufacturing factories in Vietnam, and support them to be able to manage their workplace effectively and sustainably.

Course objectives

1. Apply the management system approach through the PDCA lens that can help factories to consistently improve their performance.
2. Understand the process and stages of risk management systems, approaches and tools to be used.
3. Gain an in-depth knowledge on risk management perspectives, including hazards, risks and controls inside a factory, a comprehensive risk assessment, the hierarchy of controls and implement relevant controls, the basic components of review and monitor process, design of a risk register and implement.

Key contents

In this course, participants will learn about:

- What is a management system?
- What is risk management?
- What is hazard, risk and control?
- How to perform risk assessment.
- Implement suitable controls.
- Review and monitor, maintain a risk register.

Target participants

- Factory top management.
- Management team members.
- Compliance staff/managers.
- HR and OSH staff/managers and staff in charge of work safety.
- Internal auditing team.
- Production supervisors/managers

Learning outcomes

- Understand the basic concepts of management systems under PDCA thinking and relates where the risk management fits under this framework.
- Have a broader understanding of different hazards, risks and controls applicable in the factory.
- Understand the basic and important concepts of how to do a risk assessment in a real context.
- Have a deeper understanding of applying the hierarchy of controls to effective risk management.
- Identify steps of preparing a risk register, the importance of it and finally drafting a policy of risk management and control.

► Training methods



Participatory online training approach, which participants have a lot of active learning opportunities including group discussions, case studies, etc.
