

**Tripartite Meeting on Improving Employment
and Working Conditions in Health Services**

Geneva
24–28 April 2017

Proposed points for discussion

1. What challenges and opportunities do governments and the social partners experience in promoting decent work in the health services sector – particularly regarding employment creation, employment conditions, gender equality, skills development, and safe, healthy working conditions? How do these affect access to health services and provision of quality care?
2. What guidance, policies, strategies, programmes and tools are required to ensure decent work in the health services sector? What gaps in such policies and tools have been experienced and how could these be addressed?
3. How could social dialogue be enhanced to better contribute to addressing the challenges regarding decent work in health services? In this regard, what has been the experience in different countries?
4. Recommendations for future action by the International Labour Organization, governments, employers' and workers' organizations regarding the promotion of decent work and employment in the health services sector.
