



## Technical meeting on decent and sustainable work in the inland waterways sector

20 – 24 November 2023, Geneva

### ► Points for discussion

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1. What are the opportunities and challenges for advancing decent work in the inland waterways sector, including in light of key developments and structural issues, such as climate change, technological innovation and informality, that affect the world of work?
2. Which policies, measures and practices have been effective, which have not worked, and what policies and institutions are required in order to promote decent work in the inland waterways sector, for example in terms of fundamental principles and rights at work, job creation, working conditions, just transition, attraction and retention of workers, sustainable enterprise development, formalization, social protection and social dialogue?
3. Taking into account the International Labour Organization's mandate, and the diversity across regions and local context in the inland waterways sector, what recommendations can be made for future action by the Office and the ILO Constituents (governments, employers' and workers' organizations) in the inland waterways sector? What should be the ILO's priorities in order to assist constituents to capitalize on the opportunities?
