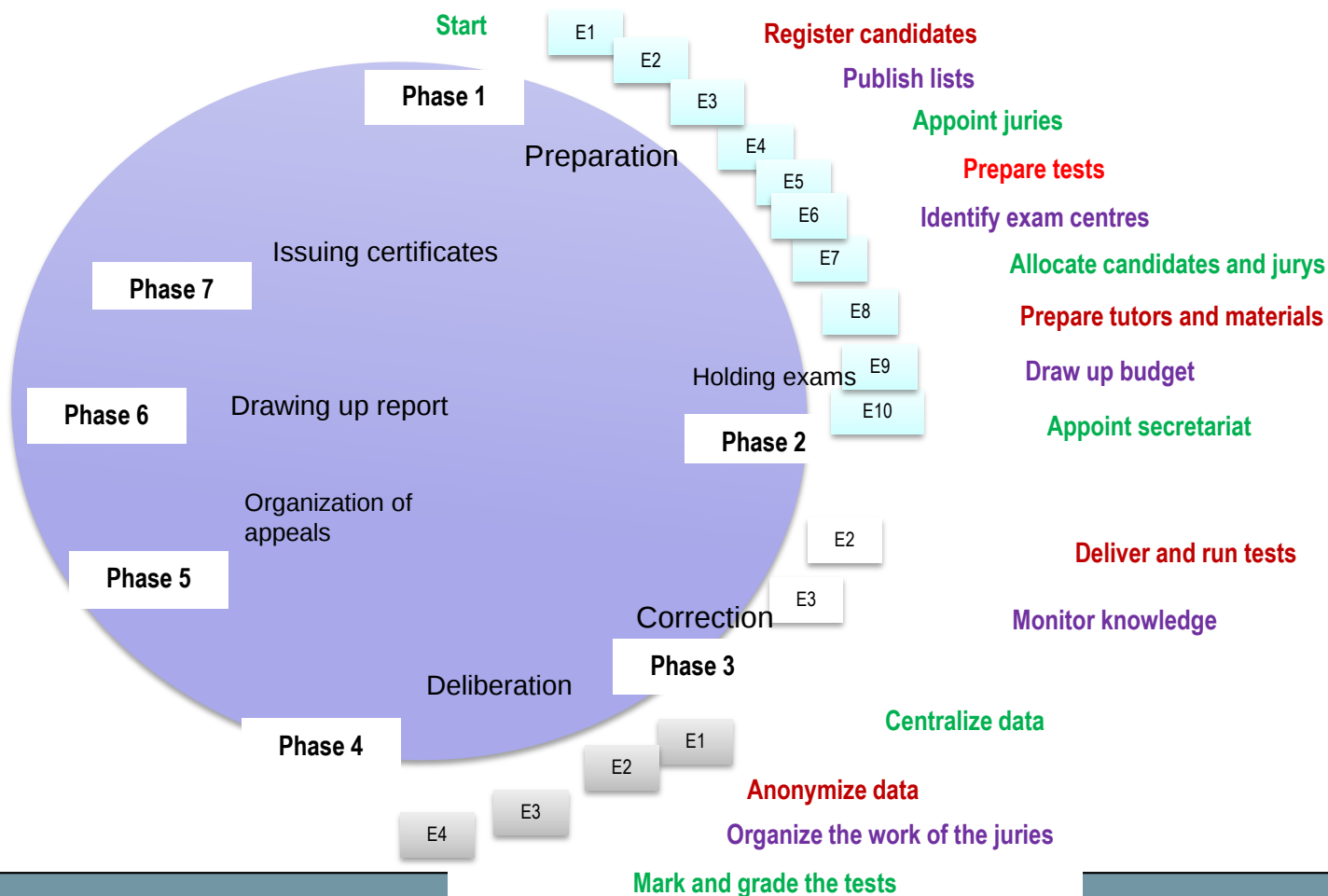
3-Participants and their roles

Actors	Roles or missions
Artisan collectives	- Play a major role in organizing EAEs - Organize the General Assembly to launch the EAE process - Receive candidates' entries - Have the major role in running EAE managing bodies - Collect exam fees on behalf of the organizing committee
Local authority	- Set framework conditions (order for official establishment of the exams, order to create EAE managing bodies, order to nominate the artisanal sector focal point) - Take part in the running of the commune consultative council - Sign the list of candidates admitted
Artisans' association	- Contribute to the smooth running of the process of organizing EAEs - Inform affiliated and non-affiliated members of the same corporation
Association of apprentices' parents	- Take part in the EAE organizing bodies - Raise awareness among apprentices' parents and tutors to enable them to play their part well - Contribute to improving apprenticeship
Employers	- Train apprentices - Set tests - Sit on juries
Artisan sector focal point	- Facilitate collaboration between the local authority and artisans - Take part in the running of EAE managing bodies - Provide technical support to the collective of artisans' associations
Development association	- Take part in the work of the commune consultative council - Be involved in raising public awareness

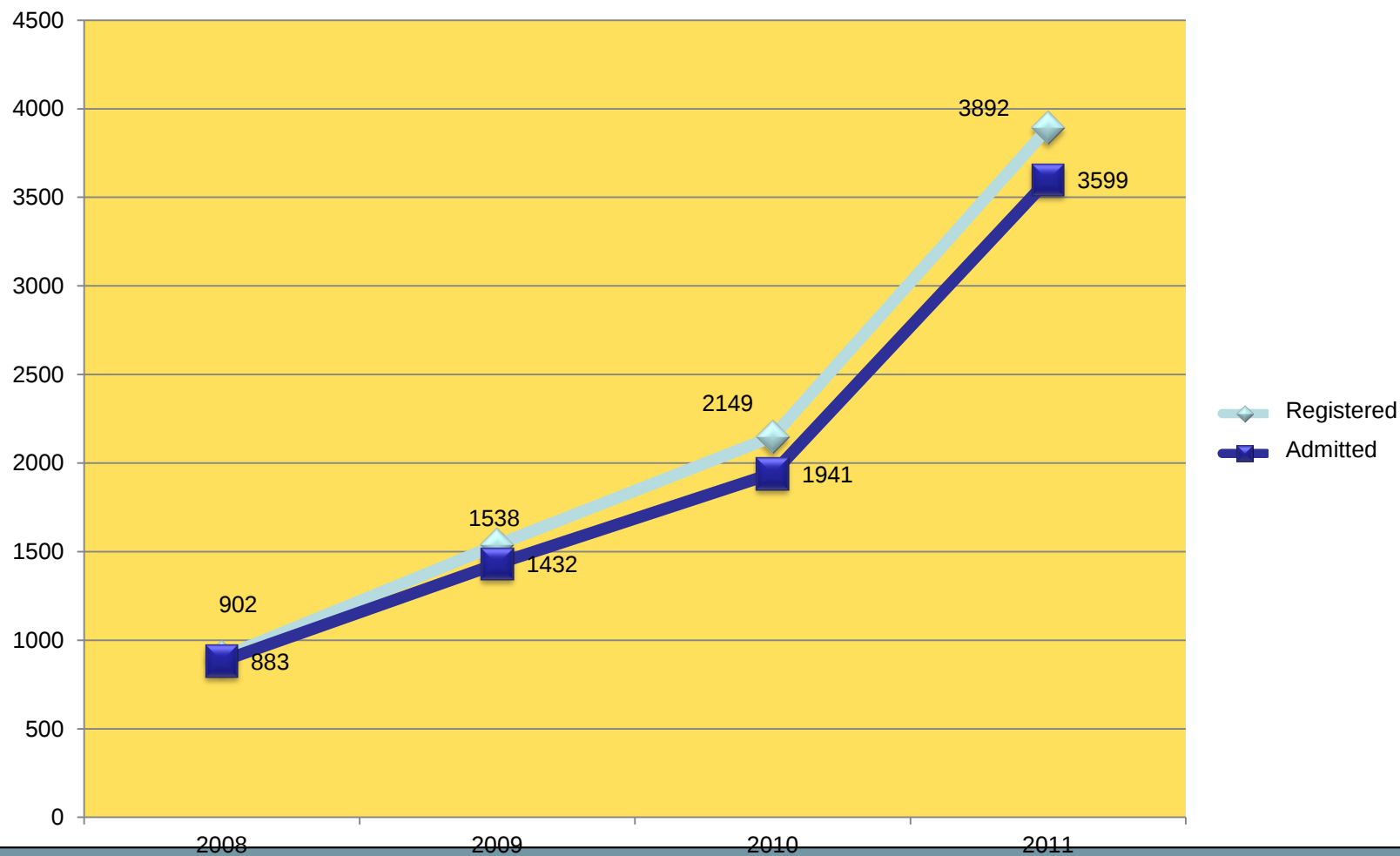

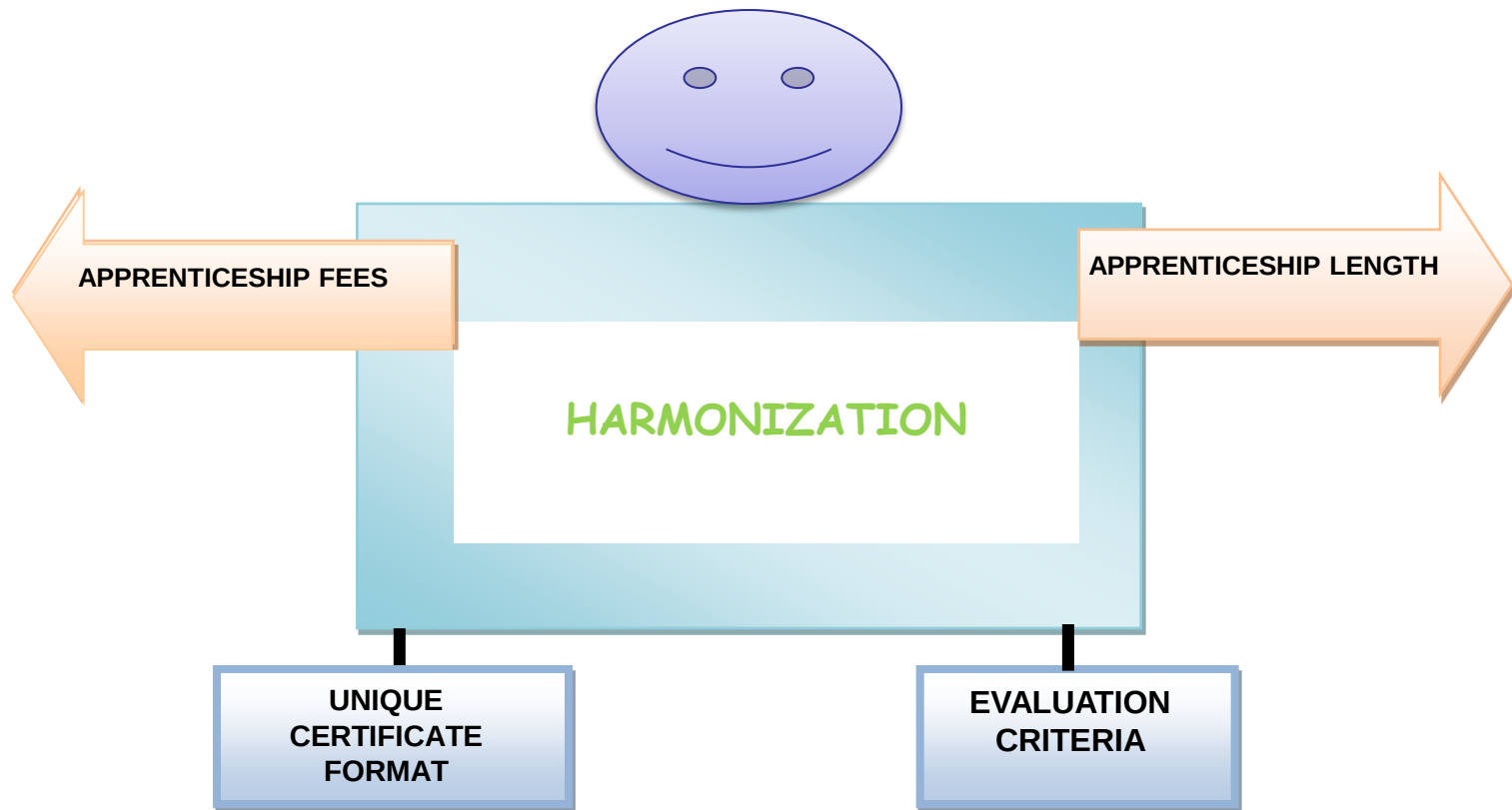

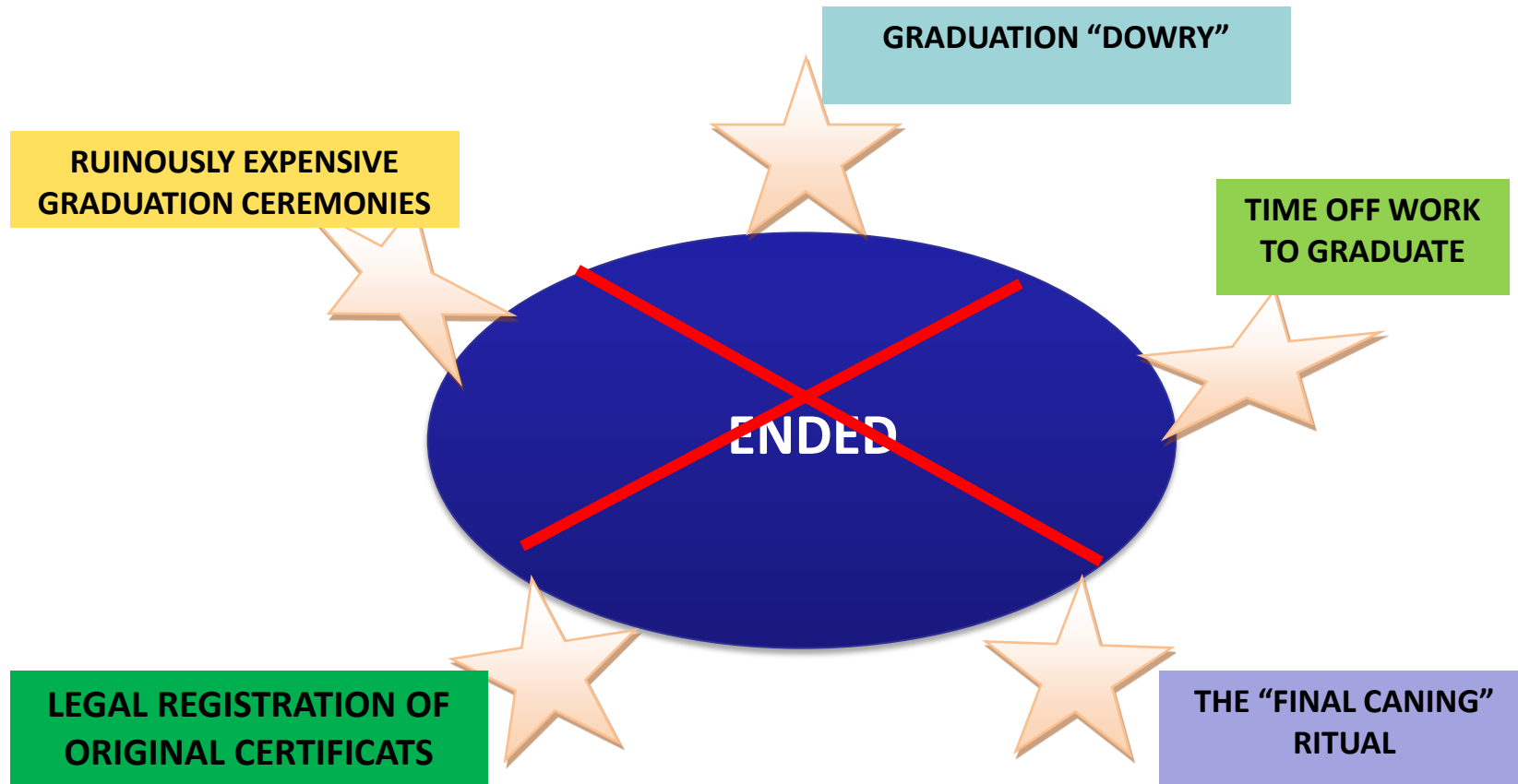

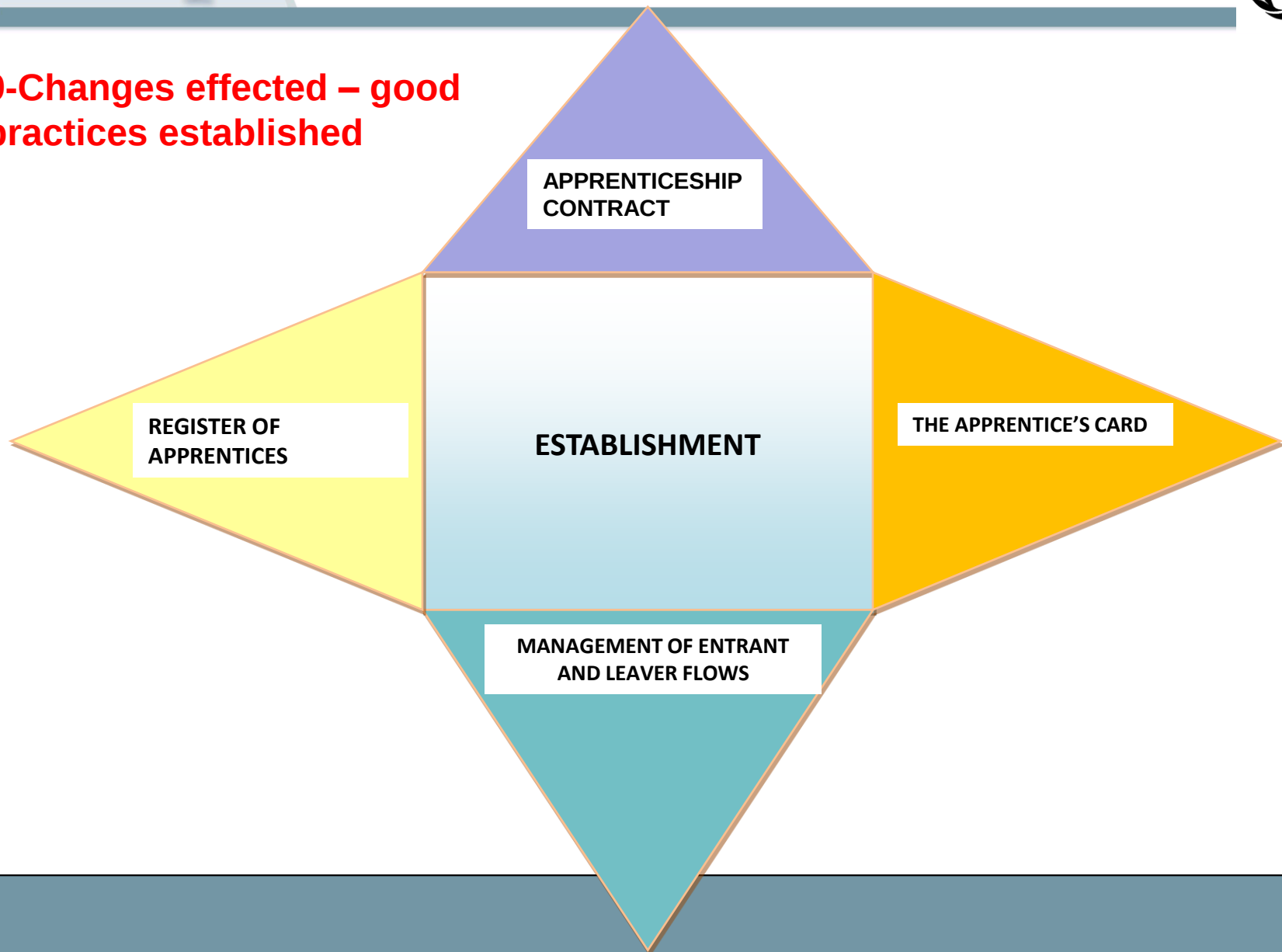

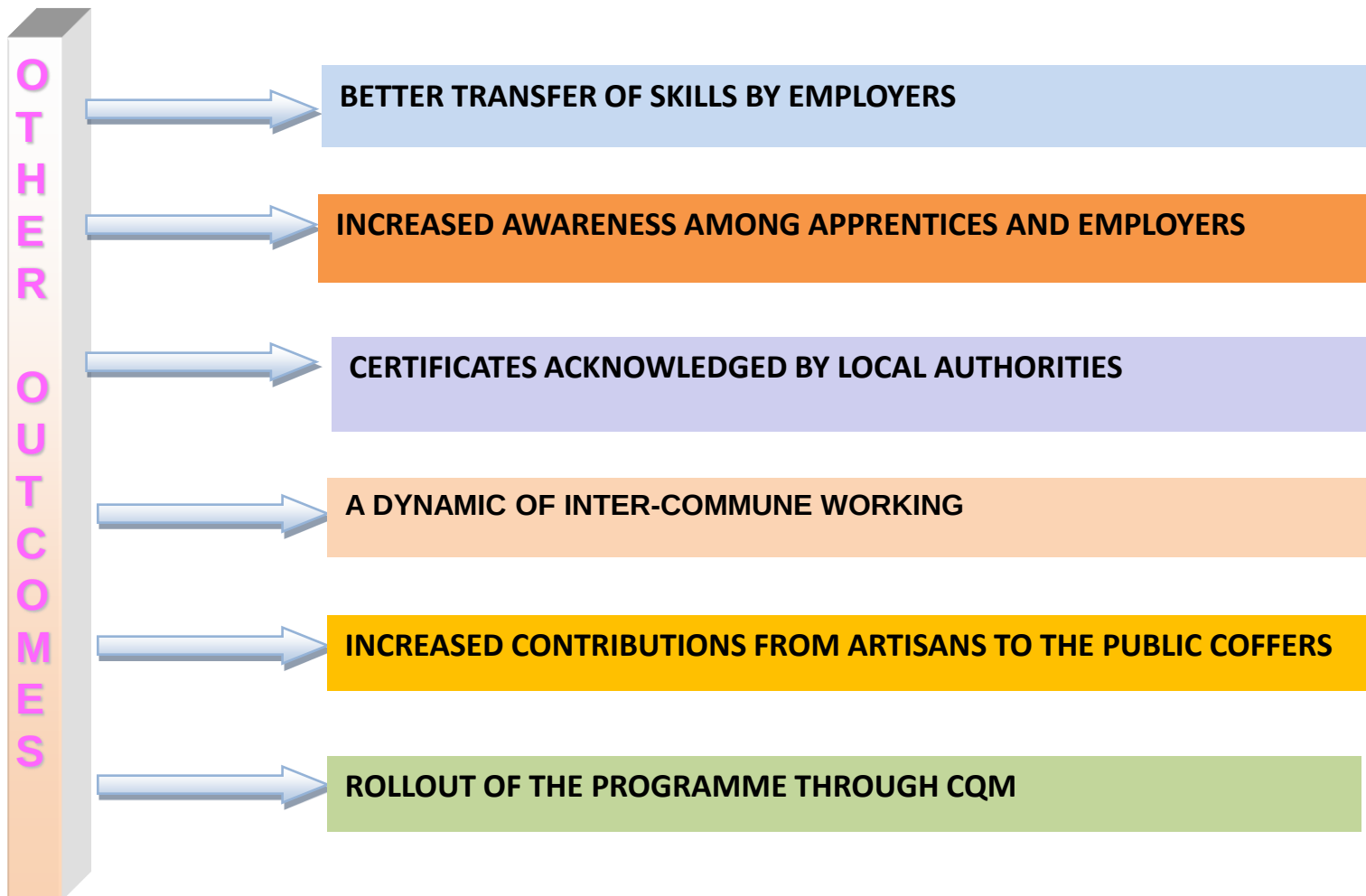
