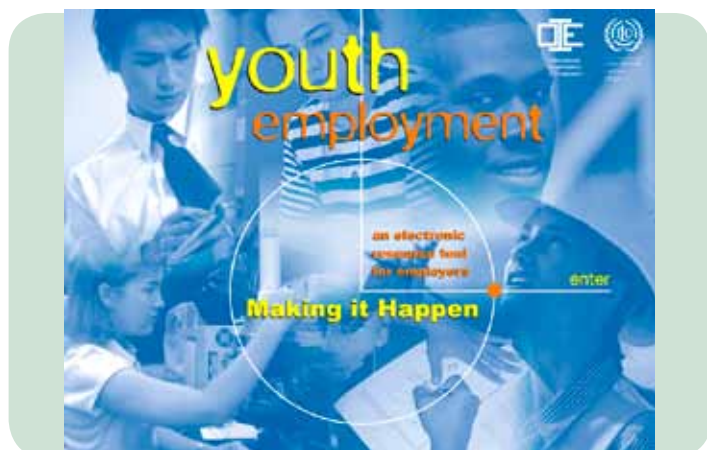

What is Youth Employment: Making it Happen?

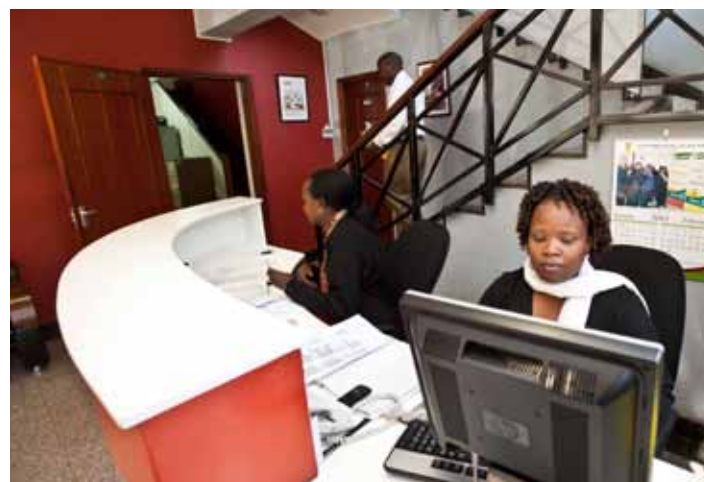
An electronic tool to strengthen the capacity of employers' organizations to engage in youth employment, especially in developing and transition countries, in use since 2008
