

Youth Employment Inventory (YEI) Tunisia



The Youth Employment Inventory Tunisia is a comprehensive database of 83 active labour market programmes targeted at young people. The interventions include skills training, entrepreneurship promotion, employment services and subsidized employment – either as a stand-alone or combined intervention. Information about the geographic coverage, scale and targeting characteristics of each intervention is complemented by information about their design, costs, implementation and financing mechanisms. The YEI also contains results from the monitoring and evaluation of youth employment interventions to allow for a better understanding of their effectiveness.

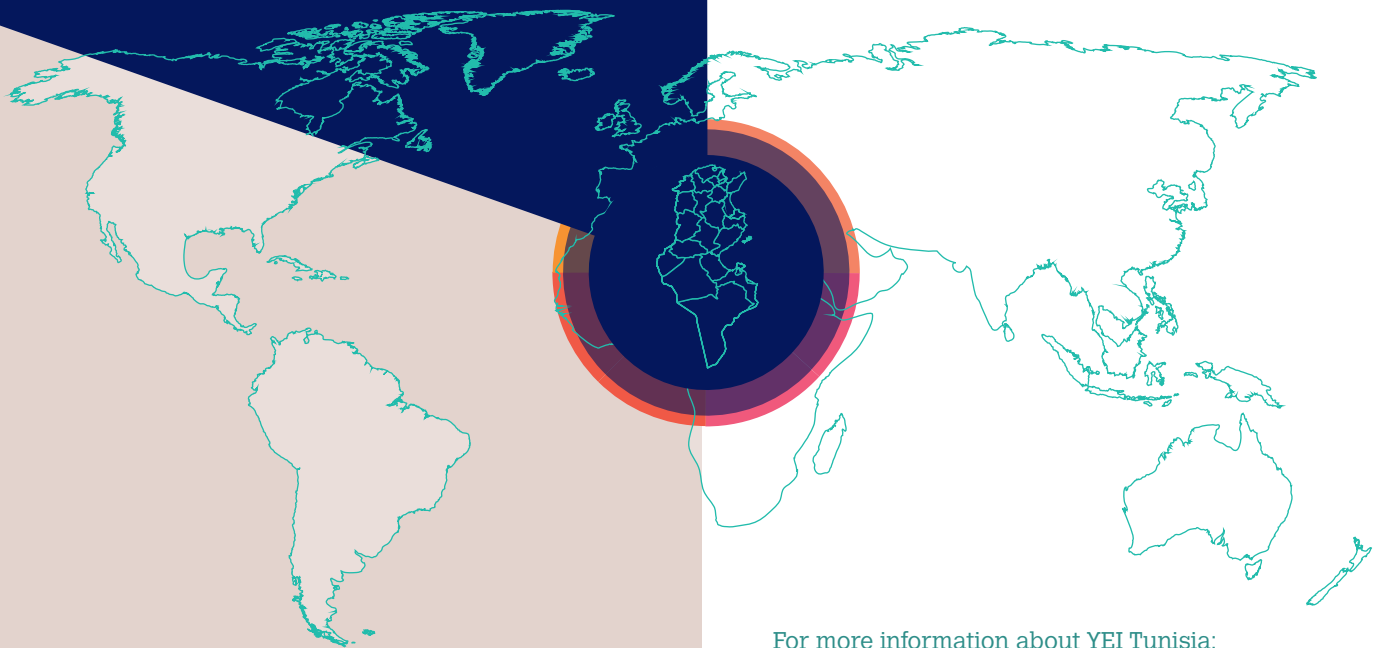

The Youth Employment Inventory (YEI) is a multi-agency initiative aimed at collecting information and evidence on youth employment programmes around the world. The YEI is the first comprehensive database to provide comparative information on the design, implementation and effectiveness of youth employment interventions.

In 2014, the International Labour Organization (ILO) carried out a country inventory of **youth employment interventions in Tunisia** to shed light on intervention trends and to provide the basis for further research. Information about 83 youth employment interventions recorded in the **YEI Tunisia** was generated through extensive desk research and complemented by structured interviews with implementing agencies in Tunisia.
