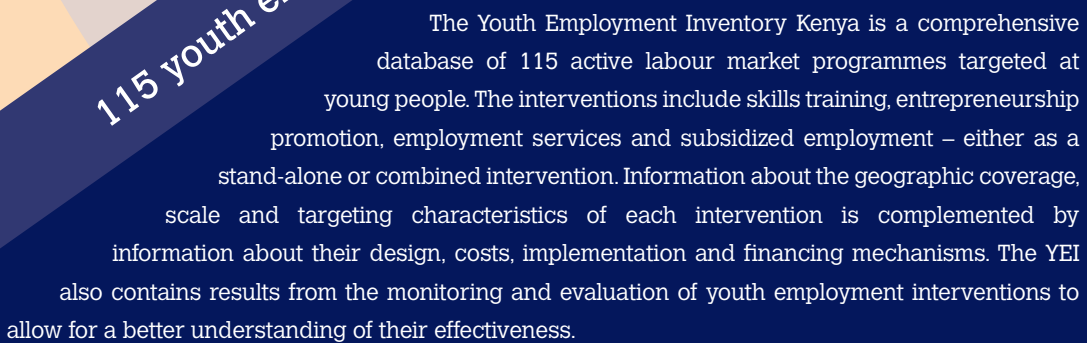


Youth Employment Inventory (YEI) Kenya

70% of all interventions are implemented by non-governmental organizations (NGOs) in Kenya is massive. NGOs are involved in about

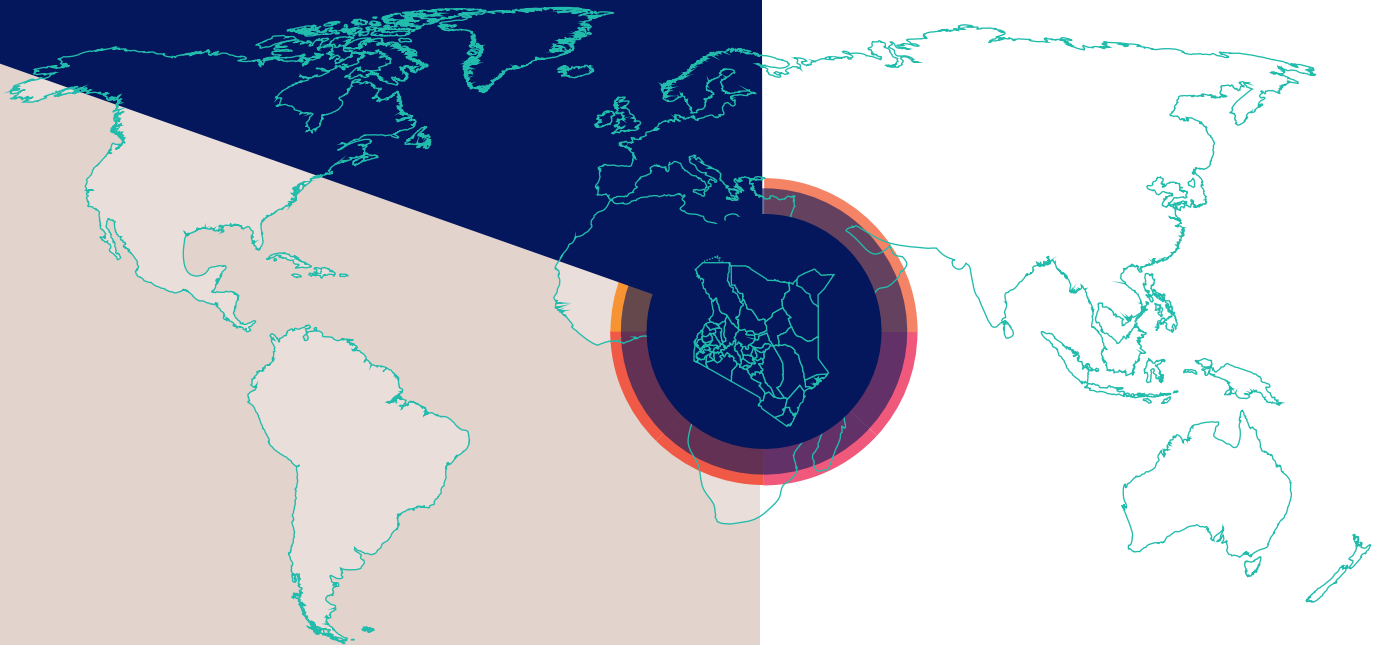
The majority of the interventions target up to 5,000 young people

The Youth Employment Inventory (YEI) is a multi-agency initiative aimed at collecting information and evidence on youth employment programmes around the world. The YEI is the first comprehensive database to provide comparative information on the design, implementation and effectiveness of youth employment interventions.

In 2013, the International Labour Organization (ILO) carried out a country inventory of **youth employment interventions in Kenya** to shed light on intervention trends and to provide the basis for further research. Information about **115 youth employment interventions** recorded in the **YEI Kenya** was generated through extensive desk research and complemented by structured interviews with implementing agencies in Kenya.
