Objective: This project intends to contribute to the reduction of the incidence of children serving in armies and/or in armed groups (development objective). By the end of the project, (1) there will be an enabling environment in each country, facilitating the prevention, withdrawal and subsequent reintegration into society of children involved in armed conflict, (2) former child soldiers above the minimum working age will be assisted to acquire decent work and achieve a sustainable income and (3) fewer children will be recruited in armed conflict in targeted countries.

Objective: The aim of this project is to contribute to the reduction of the incidence of children associated with armed forces and groups and other worst forms of child labour (WFCL) in (post) conflict situations by providing decent work. By the end of the project, (1) there will be improved capacity to deal with the WFCL through setting up and strengthening coordination mechanisms, adapting the legal framework and developing NAP and (2) children and young people affected by armed conflicts will have acquired decent work and achieved sustainable income.
