Objective: This project will contribute to the elimination of the worst forms of child labour (WFCL) in the Southern African Customs Union (SACU) region by supporting the national Plan of Action in South Africa and enhancing the capacity to address this issue in Botswana, Lesotho, Namibia and Swaziland (BLNS countries). By the end of the project, (1) there will be more effective policies and programmes for tackling child labour, especially in its worst forms, in South Africa, (2) models of intervention for dealing with selected WFCL in South Africa will have been developed to inform policy, (3) there will be an enabling environment for the elimination of WFCL in the BLNS countries, leading to effective national interventions against this problems and (4) there will be more effective policies and programmes for tackling sub-regional child labour issues, especially in its worst forms, in the SACU region.
