Dear all.

In our opinion, such an issue should not be raised, which for the Pancyprian Federation of Labour PEO is a matter of substance and cannot be reduced to a legalistic debate.

It is clear that the right to strike is directly and compulsorily linked to the Freedom of Association and Protection of the Right to Organize which is enshrined in Convention 87 of the ILO and is in full accordance with the spirit and framework of the Convention in particular Article 3 thereof.

This position, apart from the concurring interpretation of the ILO Committee of Experts, is also confirmed by the fact that for decades the self-evident interpretation that the right to strike is included and guaranteed by Convention 87 has been accepted by all.
