

**Information for delegates and observers regarding parking facilities at the
97th Session of the International Labour Conference**

As has been the case in recent years, parking spaces at the Palais (United Nations) for delegates to the 97th Session of the International Labour Conference are in extremely short supply.

The Office has a very limited number of parking permits which it will make available to Government delegates on a first come, first served basis, for the parking area outside Door 13. Government delegates should bear in mind, however, that they will **not** need a parking permit to gain entry to the United Nations if their automobile has diplomatic license plates. Such vehicles must be parked in the areas reserved for permanent missions (the P10 parking area by Door 40; Level B of the underground parking lot for Building E; and the “Secretariat Court” by Door 6.)

In view of the above, delegates are strongly encouraged to use the parking facilities at the ILO and to use the shuttle bus service between the ILO and the Palais.
