

Decision on the 12th item on the agenda: Reports of the Officers of the Governing Body

Third report: Representation alleging non-observance by Colombia of the Discrimination (Employment and Occupation) Convention, 1958 (No. 111), the Tripartite Consultation (International Labour Standards) Convention, 1976 (No. 144), and the Collective Bargaining Convention, 1981 (No. 154), made under article 24 of the ILO Constitution by the General Confederation of Workers

In the light of the information presented in the report, and on the recommendation of its Officers, the Governing Body decided that the representation was receivable with respect to Conventions Nos 111 and 144 and set up a tripartite committee to examine the representation. The Governing Body decided that the representation was not receivable in respect of Convention No. 154.
