

Abrogation of Convention 50

**ABROGATION OF THE RECRUITING
OF INDIGENOUS WORKERS CONVENTION, 1936 (No. 50)**

The General Conference of the International Labour Organization,
Having been convened at Geneva by the Governing Body of the
International Labour Office, and having met in its 107th Session
on 28 May 2018, and

Following consideration of the proposal for the abrogation of
six international labour Conventions and withdrawal of three
international labour Recommendations under the seventh item
on the agenda of the session,

decides this fifth day of June of the year two thousand and eighteen to
abrogate the Recruiting of Indigenous Workers Convention, 1936 (No. 50).

The Director-General of the International Labour Office shall notify
all Members of the International Labour Organization, as well as the
Secretary-General of the United Nations, of this decision to abrogate the
Convention.

The English and French versions of the text of this decision are equally
authoritative.
