Report of the Director-General

Sixth Supplementary Report: Withdrawal of the representation alleging non-observance by Uruguay of the Dock Work Convention, 1973 (No. 137), made under article 24 of the ILO Constitution by the Single Union of Port and Allied Workers

1. In communications dated 8 and 15 February 2019, the Single Union of Port and Allied Workers (SUPRA) made a representation to the International Labour Office under article 24 of the ILO Constitution alleging non-observance by Uruguay of the Dock Work Convention, 1973 (No. 137). At its 336th Session (June 2019), the Governing Body decided that the representation was receivable and to set up a tripartite committee to examine it.¹
2. In a communication dated 13 August 2019, before the members of the tripartite committee were appointed, SUPRA reports that, as a result of collective bargaining, an agreement has been reached with the employers and the Government of Uruguay. Accordingly, SUPRA gives formal notification that it has withdrawn the representation and requests that the case be closed.

Draft decision

3. *The Governing Body took note of the request submitted by the Single Union of Port and Allied Workers (SUPRA) and declared that the representation had been withdrawn and that the case was closed.*
