Montenegro

Failure to reply to all or most CEACR comments

The Government has provided the following written information.

Montenegro has been recognized as one of the cases by the Committee of Experts due to substantial violations of reporting obligations or other obligations related to the ILO standards. The Government of Montenegro acknowledges that its reporting obligations for the past year have not been met.

The Government is committed to ensuring the timely submission of its reporting obligations on ILO Conventions. Significant effort was put into submitting the article 22 Reports in 2022. Due to an unprecedented cyberattack that impacted the digital infrastructure of the Government in August :2022, all efforts made towards the preparations of reports were lost, thus requiring the process to commence anew.

The Government will provide information for reports due for 2022 and most of the reports due for 2023. The reports will be sent according to the established deadline, between 1 June and 1 September 2023.
