Reports of the Officers of the Governing Body

First report: Closure of the representation alleging non-observance by Chile of the Promotional Framework for Occupational Safety and Health Convention, 2006 (No. 187), pursuant to a successful conciliation process

1. In a communication dated 20 October 2022, the Trade Union Association of Forestry Contractors A.G. (ACOFORAG A.G.), made a representation to the International Labour Office under article 24 of the ILO Constitution alleging non-observance by Chile of the Promotional Framework for Occupational Safety and Health Convention, 2006 (No. 187). At its 347th Session, the Governing Body, in the light of the information contained in document GB.347/INS/19/3, and taking into consideration the recommendation of its Officers, decided that the representation was receivable and to set up a tripartite committee to examine it.
2. On 18 December 2023, the ACOFORAG A.G. communicated an agreement signed between the parties, which had been reached as a result of a conciliation process, and indicated that the agreement put an end to its claim under the representation procedure.

3. **The Governing Body, noting that an agreement had been reached between the parties concerned following a conciliation process, and on the recommendation of its Officers, decided to close the procedure of the representation alleging non-observance by Chile of the Promotional Framework for Occupational Safety and Health Convention, 2006 (No. 187).**
