Approval of the Additional Migration Convention signed with the Republic of Peru Protocol.

Passed: October 24, 2001.

Promulgated: November 19, 2001.

The Senate and House of Representatives of Argentina in Congress assembled, etc.. enact as law:

SECTION 1 - Approval of the ADDITIONAL PROTOCOL TO THE CONVENTION OF MIGRATION BETWEEN ARGENTINA REPUBLIC AND THE REPUBLIC OF PERU, signed in Buenos Aires on December 21, 1999, consisting of two (2) items, as certified photocopy form part of this Act .

SECTION 2 - Communicate to the Executive Branch.

ADDITIONAL PROTOCOL TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARGENTINA MIGRATION AND THE REPUBLIC OF PERU

The Government of Argentina and the Government of the Republic of Peru, hereinafter the Parties;

In order to extend the deadline for migration regularization of their national, established in Article 2, clause b) of the Migration Agreement between Argentina and the Republic of Peru on August 12, 1998, hereinafter "the Convention";

Have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I

Extended for 180 days, the deadline set in Article 2 paragraph b) of the Migration Agreement between Argentina and the Republic of Peru, to which nationals of a Party, who were in an irregular situation in the territory of the other to time of entry into force of the Convention, submit your request to regularize migration and documentation provided for in Article 4 of the Convention, to the appropriate migration service for the purpose of developing formal activities as employees or independent.

SECTION 2

The period laid down in Article I shall start from the date of entry into force of this Protocol.

This Protocol shall be ratified and enter into force on the date on which the instruments of ratification are exchanged.

This Protocol shall be an integral part of the "Agreement".
