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Discussing the needs of Ukrainian Migrant Domestic Workers

Kyiv, Ukraine, 24 June 2014

The Global Action Programme on Migrant Domestic Workers and their Families (GAP-MDW) was presented by Maria Elena Valenzuela, the CTA of the project, at the Conference “Effective Governance of Labour Migration and its Skills Dimensions” in Kyiv on 24 June 2014, gathering 60 participants, among which governmental officers, workers’ and employers’ representatives, academic community, civil society organizations and UN agencies.

The project was received with interest by the audience and generated a constructive dialogue on further steps to be taken by the state in order to guarantee the right and integration of returnee migrants into the Ukrainian society. The ILO Convention 189 on Domestic Work was recognized as an important tool in advancing the agenda of equitable rights for domestic workers.
