Global Action Programme on Migrant Domestic Workers
and their Families

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Knowledge Sharing Platform created spaces for information exchange and empowerment of domestic and migrant domestic workers

Knowledge Sharing Platform/Community of Practice (KSP/CoP) was designed and hosted on the International Domestic Workers Federation's (IDWF) website (please visit link: <http://www.idwfed.org/en/community>) with the support of the EU funded Global Action Programme on Migrant Domestic Workers (GAP-MDW).

Three regional meetings/training workshops (Hong Kong – 27 to 29 April 2014, Chile – 22 to 26 September 2014, Burkina Faso – 18 to 21 October 2014) were organized to agree on the structure and content of the CoP with IDWF affiliates.

The IDWF CoP was launched on 16 December 2014 at the ILO "Trade Union Regional Workshop on Capacity Building of Domestic Workers Organizations and Elimination of Child Domestic Labour" in Indonesia. During the launch, an introductory video clip on IDWF CoP was also broadcasted.

Since its creation, more than 4,000 members have joined the Knowledge Sharing Platform and were enabled to use its tool. During the last quarter more than 1,630 users, both new and returning, have had at least one session on the KSP. Only in February 2015 there were 2,361 sessions on the platform, among which 54.98% are from organic search.

The KSP is not only a key space of communication for the MDWs and a source of information on their rights, but is also an important channel of dissemination of advocacy materials and tools.
