RESOLUTION

The members of the Steering Committee (SC) of the EU-ILO Project “Towards safe, healthy and declared work in Ukraine”, having discussed the items in accordance with the agenda of its second meeting (attached) agreed on the following:

1. Steering Committee approves its revised composition (inclusion of representatives of Ombudsman and of Ministry of Health).
2. Steering Committee takes note of the EU-ILO Project implementation and key deliverables in 2020.
3. Steering Committee encourages all parties involved to consider the EU-ILO Project technical recommendations to the draft law on OSH and to conduct, if necessary, additional technical consultations, meetings and/or thematic round tables with the most representative national employers’ organizations’ associations and the most representative national trade union organizations’ associations to approximate positions regarding the draft law content and, where appropriate, with Verkhovna Rada Committee on Social Policy and Protection of Veterans’ Rights. The Steering Committee also takes into consideration the timeframe, foreseen by the Ministry of Economy, for the process towards its adoption and encourages Project to adapt to it.
4. Taking into account the advantage of the active involvement of the EU-ILO Project, at technical level, in the legal acts drafting process and the importance of qualified and timely technical support on the spot, the Steering Committee supports the following forms of collaboration, aimed at achieving a better alignment of the draft legal acts with the ILO and EU standards on the issues covered by the Project:
 - a) Project should be involved in the process of drafting legal acts since the earliest stages, interact and support the technical work groups during the legal acts drafting process, and provide timely technical advice and recommendations on the spot;
 - b) Project should provide technical consultations to the work groups whenever needed;
 - c) Such support should be provided without prejudice to more formal requests of the national constituents to the ILO for comments to the drafted legal acts at a later stage.

5. Steering Committee endorses the proposed amendments to the EU-ILO Project workplan and stresses the relevance of its adjustment, if needed, to changing circumstances and to the timeframes of the national stakeholders.
6. Steering Committee takes note on the *status quo* of the draft Action Plan on Undeclared Work and invites EU-ILO Project to provide necessary support to the Ministry of Economy in the resubmission of the draft action plan already agreed upon by national stakeholders for further consultations with social partners and other interested parties, its revision, if necessary, and its resubmission to CMU for adoption. The stakeholders are therefore encouraged to provide their suggestions to that draft action plan.
7. All parties represented in the EU-Project Steering Committee are encouraged to actively participate in the project activities, in accordance with its work plan.
8. To conduct the next sitting in May 2021 or earlier, if necessary.
