Decisions

3. Ministry of Social Policy and State Labour Service - to set up the tripartite technical workgroup for development of the tables of concordance of the national legislation with the EU directives and ILO conventions:
 - a) **on occupational safety and health:** directives 89/391/EEC (OSH framework), 89/654/EEC (workplaces), 89/656 EEC (PPE), 2009/104/EC (work equipment), ILO conventions 155, 187
 - b) **on labour relations:** directives 91/533/EEC (obligations to inform), 2003/88/EC (working time)
4. All parties represented in the EU-Project Steering Committee are encouraged to take part in the project activities in accordance with the workplan.
5. To conduct the next sitting in May 2018.
