RESOLUTION

The members of the Steering Committee (SC) of the EU-ILO Project “Towards safe, healthy and declared work in Ukraine”, having discussed the items in accordance with the agenda of its fourth meeting (attached) agreed on the following:

1. Regarding the **membership in the Project Steering Committee**, the Steering Committee welcomes the new representative of the Federation of Trade Unions, Vasyl Andreyev, the FTUU Deputy Head, Head of Trade Union of construction and construction materials’ workers of Ukraine as well as Ms. Natalia Nenuchenko, recently appointed as a Secretary of the NTSEC Secretariat.
2. Regarding the **mid-term internal evaluation** of 18 months of Project implementation, the Steering Committee endorses the conclusions and takes into account the proposed recommendations. It also encourages for its practical implementation, in particular the Project team is invited to explore the possibilities of training the pool of trainers on OSH and of supporting the digitalization of the SLS work processes); and the national stakeholders are invited to advocate the Project recommendations at the higher political levels.
3. Regarding the **Project implementation**, the Steering Committee takes note of the EU-ILO Project key deliverables since the previous SC meeting (from July to September 2021) and invites the national stakeholders to take into account, during further tripartite discussions, the Project technical recommendations to the draft legal acts aimed at transposing the EU OSH individual directives, as well as draft laws on labour relations

and State Supervision (control) of compliance with labour legislation. The Steering Committee also invites the Project to participate in the tripartite consultations in order to provide additional technical advice to these and other topics covered by the Project.

4. Regarding **management arrangements**, the Steering Committee thanks Mr. Antonio Santos for the fruitful collaboration and welcomes the new Project Manager Mr. Zsolt Dudás. The Steering Committee encourages the national stakeholders to hold bilateral meetings and multilaterals consultations with the Project team to update priorities and discuss the workplan until the end 2022.
5. To conduct the **next sitting** of the Steering Committee in April 2022, or earlier, if needed.
