RESOLUTION

The members of the Steering Committee (SC) of the EU-ILO Project “Towards safe, healthy and declared work in Ukraine”, having discussed the items in accordance with the agenda of its 5th meeting (attached) agreed on the following:

1. The Steering Committee (SC) welcomes Ms. Olena Kolobrodova, a new representative of the Ombudsman, as a member of the SC.
2. Regarding the **approximation of the national legislation on OSH, labour inspection and some aspects of the labour relations to the ILO and EU standards**, the SC takes into considerations of the suggestions and information provided and encourages the Project to continue the follow up and technically support the ongoing process of reform and alignment of the related national legal framework with ILO and EU standards and good practices.
3. Regarding the **psychosocial support (PSS) at workplace in war at post-war times**, the SC recommends the parties of the social dialogue to provide to the National Socio-Economic Council (NTSEC) with the proposals and recommendations regarding the further steps to be taken to advocate and implement the PSS at workplace. The technical and methodological support of the Project in this regard is expected. The SC also suggests the NTSEC to summarise the suggestions of the parties involved and inform them about the progress.
4. Regarding the **prevention of forced labour and human trafficking**, the SC takes into consideration the information provided and encourages the Project to keep on providing the technical support to implement the proposed initiatives in order to prevent the forced labour and human trafficking and adoption of the good corporate social responsibility practices.
5. Regarding the **Guidelines on OSH in hostilities**, the SC welcomes such an initiative and calls all the parties to be engaged in the discussion of the document, when drafted, for its further validation. At the same time the SC recommends the implementing party to get consulted by the competent authorities on related subjects.
6. The Steering Committee takes into consideration the information on the need for non-cost extension of the Project until 20 April 2023.
7. To conduct **the next sitting** of the Steering Committee in February (of the non-cost extension phase is approved by the donor), or earlier, if needed.
