The Programme for the « NEET » (Not in Education, Employment or Training) 18-30 years old

1. actively identifying and seeking NEETs (by visiting places where young people gather and by building on networks and activities of grassroots organisations);
2. providing a supported pathway, first by offering tailored guidance by those organisations close to the young person;
3. once ready, guiding them to PES services in order to prepare them for suitable offers of employment or training;
4. providing aftercare and following up on participants

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Global **X'plore** :

Playful and challenging activities to discover the Brussels Vocational and Labour Market accessible to young people

Targetted **X'plore** :

Playful in the field 1 to 2 days « métiers appetizers », organized by industry (digital world, building industry, circular economy, ...)

Learning by doing approach, based on the principle of the « mini-enterprise », which aims at:

- giving youth an insight into the creation and development of a business;
- improving their understanding of the economy;
- developing their teamwork and communication skills;
- fostering decision-making and responsibility;
- stimulating and enhancing personal skills such as creativity and autonomy;
- promoting educational guidance to youth through the investigation of different aspects of business creation.

This experience is aimed at giving them the opportunity to experiment their skills “in the field”, while allowing them to be able to earn some money through the payment of their salaries, should their mini-enterprise make some profit.
