The final research will be shared at the 21st Annual Conference of the SALISES carded for later this year.



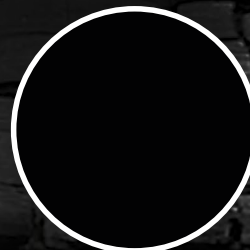
