

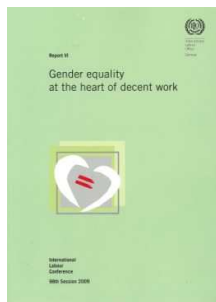

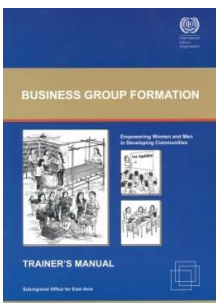


### Gender equality at the heart of decent work

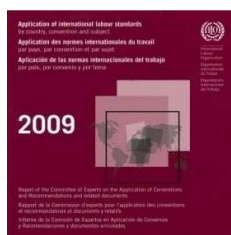
### Bulletin of labour statistics, 2009-1
