The World Day Against Child Labor (WDACL) is an annual event celebrated every **June 12** of each year by member-states of the International Labor Organization (ILO), including the Philippine since 2002 to draw attention to the global extent of child labor and the action needed to eliminate it.

This year, the global theme is "Warning! Children in Hazardous Work – End Child Labor" highlighting the global attention on the dangers of hazardous child labor. In our country, the tripartite partners and other stakeholders will celebrate the event with a local theme "Mapanganib na Paggawa, Bawal sa Bata!".
