### **Global employment trends for youth: special issue on the impact of the global economic crisis on youth**



"Youth" in this report are defined as the age group 15 to 24 years. Differences continue to exist in the

way national statistics programmes define and measure youth. Definitions of "youth" are based in part on the end use of the measurement. If one aims to measure, for example, the age span at which one is expected to enter the labour market then the statistical definition of 15 to 24 years may no longer be valid, given that today more and more young people postpone their entry into labour markets to well beyond the age of 25.

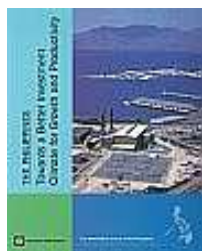

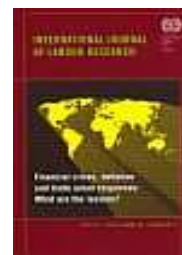
