



FINANCIAL CRISIS



Did the financial sector profit at the expense of the rest of the economy? Evidence from the United States

The study demonstrates that in the United States, the growing influence of the financial sector has led to a reduction in the share of business

investment as a per cent of value added by as much as 2 percentage points in the last three decades. This paper is to highlight the need for reforms in the neglected area. The paper also confirms the finding of the World Report 2009 that the financial sector has grown beyond reasonable boundaries and its practices have spread to the non-financial economy.



Essence of Islamic leadership and governance: a tool for personal and society transformation






2010 Philippine Statistical Yearbook
