







### Non-standard workers, collective bargaining and social dialogue: the case of South Africa. Working Paper No. 28




The paper provides valuable analysis on social dialogue and collective bargaining developments as well as

challenges in respect of non-standard workers, based on the differentiation between two inter-related processes which are generating different forms of non-standard employment: casualization, which describes a weakening of labour standards in a context in which employment remains a binary relationship; and externalization, in which employment has been externalized, resulting in a triangular employment relationship.






### Study of occupational and skill needs in green building

Demand for workers in retrofitting and new green construction is expected to grow over the coming years. Securing an adequate supply of suitably skilled workers is essential to capitalize on opportunities to further develop the sector and its potential to create jobs.

The study brings together the findings from 34 countries. It arises from a joint management agreement between the European Commission and the ILO on Knowledge sharing in early identification of skill needs.

The renewable energy sector is growing fast: about half of the new electricity-generating capacity added globally in 2008 and 2009 came from renewable energy additions. Anticipating skill needs for the low carbon economy is a complex task. The exact margins of the green economic sectors and occupations are not yet fully defined.




### Budget smart – Financial education for migrant workers and their families: training manual





