






### Persuasive communication: making the voice of business heard

up approach, with organizations at the local and grass root level offering particular potential as actors and partners in migration and development initiatives.



### Labour migration from Colombo process countries: good practices, challenges and way forward


The study highlights a number of good practices in labour migration management that can be studied, adopted, and replicated


