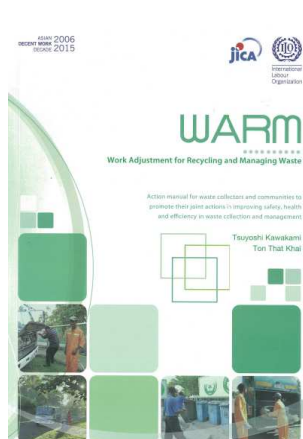

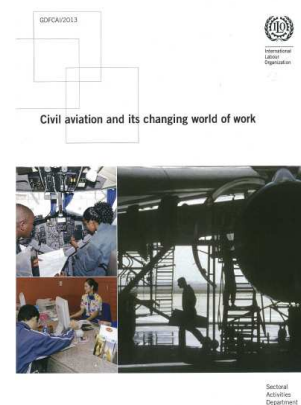

### Civil aviation and its changing world of work

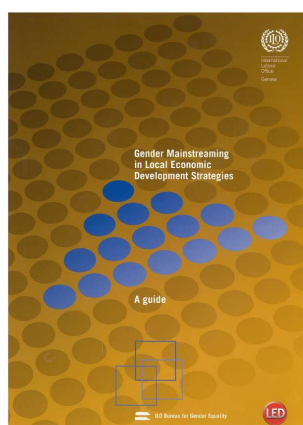

The guide is designed to assist LED practitioners – staff from international organizations, international development agencies and local authorities – in identifying and addressing the sometimes different needs and priorities of

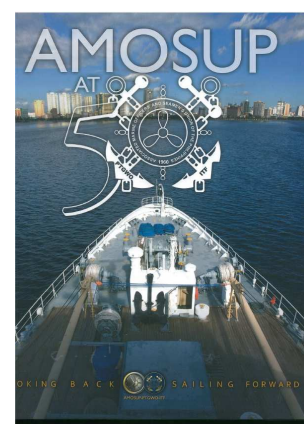

### AMOSUP: looking back, sailing forward

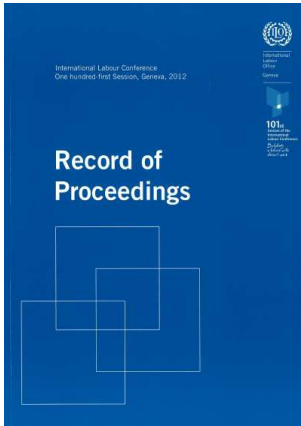
