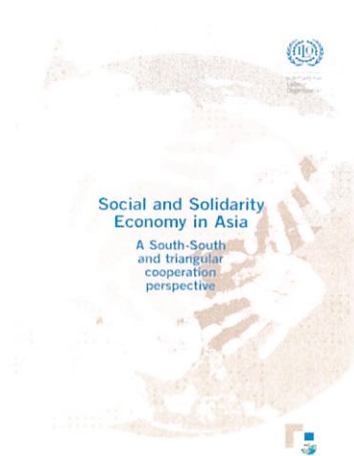

The study seeks to provide concrete evidence of South-South exchanges carried out 'from the bottom up' through the cooperation of professional organizations and community-

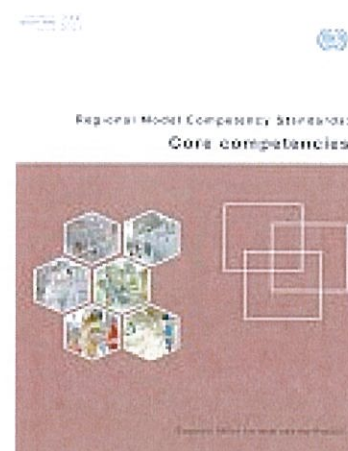

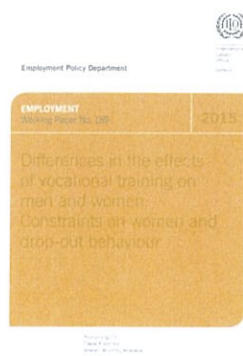
Regional model competency standards: Core competencies

Differences in the effects of vocational training on men and women: Constraints on women and drop-out behaviour

This paper provides experimental evidence on the effects of vocational and entrepreneurial training for Malawian youth, in an environment where access to schooling and formal sector employment

is extremely low. It tracks a large fraction of large fraction of programme drop-outs – a common phenomenon in the training evaluation literature – and examines the determinants and consequences of dropping out and programmes.

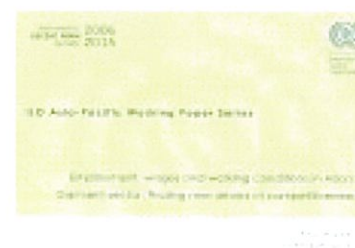

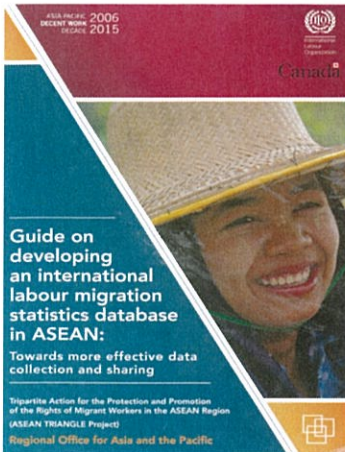
Employment, wages and working conditions in Asia's garment sector: Finding new drivers of competitiveness

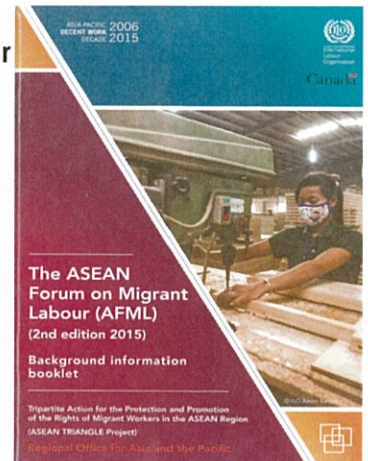
The ASEAN Forum on Migrant Labour (AFML): Background
